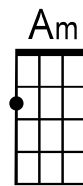
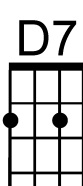
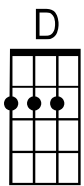
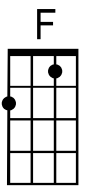
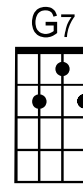
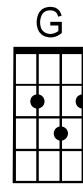
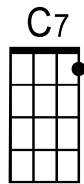
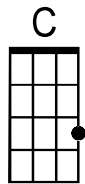


INTRODUCTION
