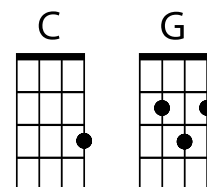
Verse 1: G

I believe in Mom and Dad, and I believe in you

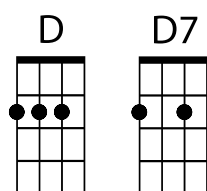


Verse 2: G
I don't believe that heaven waits for only those who congregate

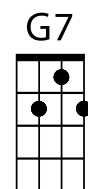
I like to think of God as love, he's down below, he's up above
