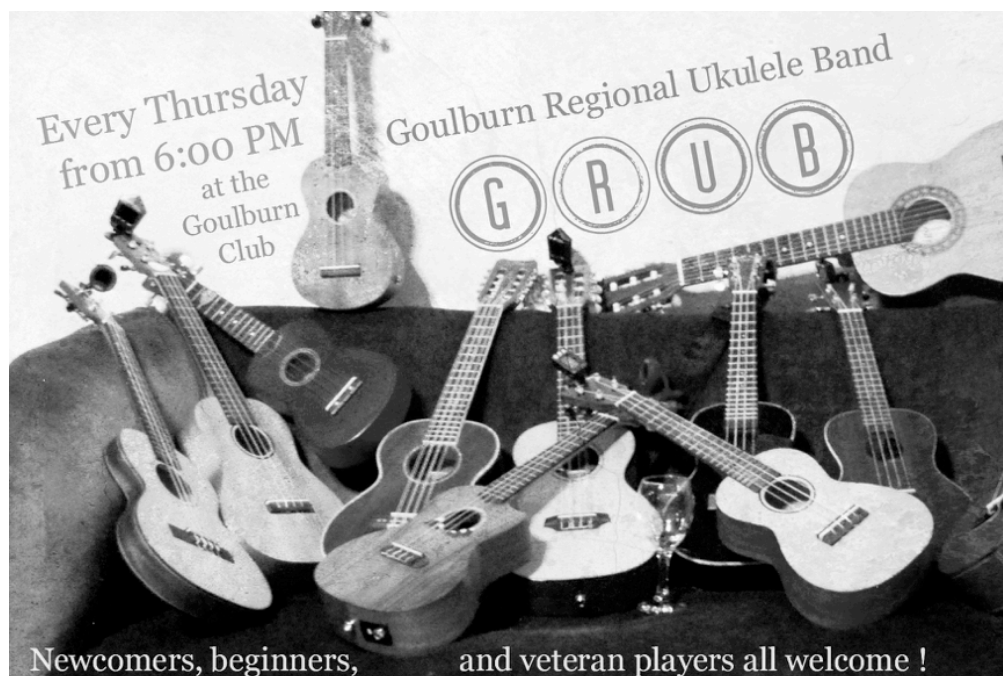

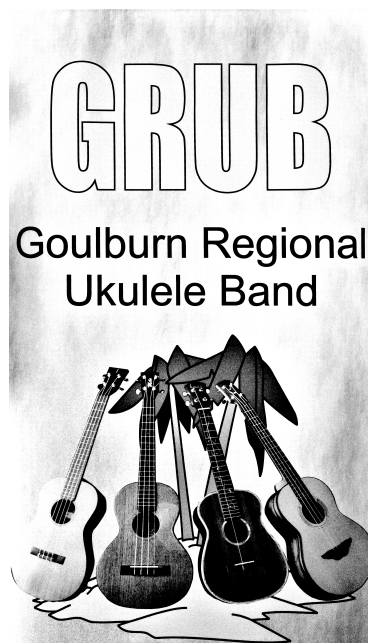

## Introduction

Each song in this book has a link to a Youtube version of the song that can be used to learn and play along with an original recorded version.

Many of the songs have been transcribed to a key that is relatively easy to play on the ukulele. Sometimes a capo is needed to play along with the Youtube version. The use of a capo is indicated at the beginning of each song for those wanting to play in the original key.

Some tablature is provided as suggestions for melody or instrumental parts of some of the songs.

Suggested chord shapes are indicated on each song sheet and a more complete list is provided at the back of the book.

An alphabetical list of the songs as well as groupings of songs that are relatively easy for beginners or fit into groups of 'Aussie Songs' or Beatles Songs' are shown in the contents.

All songs were suggested by members of GRUB and have been arranged by Ron McLaughlin for the Goulburn Regional Ukulele Band. Any other groups or players are welcome to download and use these songs for their own enjoyment.
