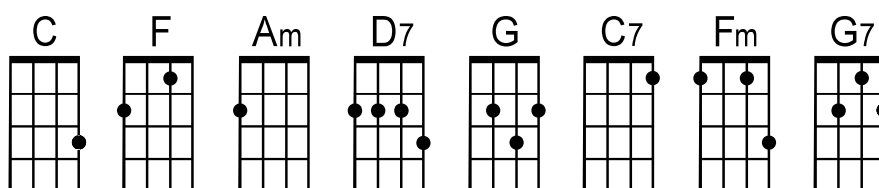
Verse 1: Put your sweet lips a little closer to the phone
